

PHOTO IDENTIFICATION CLARIFICATION

Principle

Pilgrims travel in Pilgrim Groups to the public liturgies.

The Pilgrim Leader is expected to have two forms of identification; one of which must be photographic.

Getting In

The Pilgrim Pass is needed to get in. Photo identification is for back-up.

Pilgrim Leaders

The requirement for everyone to bring photo identification has been posted on the internet and is incorporated into the Pilgrim Passport to ensure that we meet all eventualities should the security services request enhanced checks.

ACCEPTABLE PHOTO IDENTIFICATION

Photo Identification can be:

- Passport
- Driving Licence
- Freedom Pass
- Identification card from an official governmental or statutory body

Cards from student unions, clubs, societies and other similar organisation will not be acceptable.

If a Pilgrim does not have photo ID:

- Parents can verify accompanied minors
- Pilgrim Leaders can verify these members of their groups

There is no need to be concerned if a Pilgrim does not have photo ID if it is requested they will be asked to report to the accreditation point.
